BASIC ELIGIBILITY

To apply, students must be:

- Attending College or High School in the 2021 – 2022 School Year
- In good academic standing with a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent)

Additionally, a student must be in or plan to enroll in a 2-year or 4-year degree program, at a US accredited, private or public college or university.

IDEAL CANDIDATE

- An ideal candidate will have: An outstanding academic record in high school (in the top 10% of his/her graduating class) or currently holding a 3.3 or above GPA in 15 or more credits of college classes.
- Demonstrated leadership ability (e.g., as shown through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities)
- Exceptional personal success skills (e.g., emotional maturity, motivation, perseverance, etc.)

Complete the Scholarship Application appending all requested documentation. This includes an essay of approximately 500 words, single spaced on topics provided in the application
